

Code of Conduct Violation Procedure For Grades 6, 7, 8

- Lunch detention = 1 point
- After school detention when linked to third detention= 1 point
- Major offense (i.e. fighting, belligerence, integrity violation) = after school detention = 2 points.

Citizenship Grade Point System

4 points = Conference with faculty and parents to discuss next steps/consequences (plan of assistance)

6 points = In school suspension – conference with parents, principal and student

7 points = Conference with parents

8 points = Outside school suspension – conference with parents

Lunch detention and after school detention are given at teacher's discretion.

Detentions received for accumulated tardiness **WILL NOT** be reflected in the tri-mester citizenship grade.

This procedure begins anew each trimester.

- Student will return signed **white detention slip** to Mr. Cimino the following day. If for some reason Mr. Cimino is not available, detention slips will be returned to Mr. Gregor. **All slips are returned first thing in the morning, by 8:10 AM.**
- Teachers who issue any white slip will also document the incident via Renweb's behavior log. Parents should be notified via email of behavior documentations.
- Mr. Cimino will chart students' points
- *If detention slips are not returned on due date another detention will be issued.*
- Mr. Gregor will run Middle School Lunch Detentions as necessary
- If for any reason a teacher is not present please see Mrs. Heinrich for further direction
- During Lunch Detention student will complete a Reflection Form and will clean lunch tables at assigned time
- Students serving detention **WILL NOT** be permitted to heat lunches
- Students who purchased a hot lunch will proceed to the front of the lunch line They will then immediately report to the classroom
- Students are not allowed to reschedule lunch detentions for any reason

Detention Form Distribution For Grades 6, 7, 8

WHITE SLIP: Send home to parent for signature

YELLOW SLIP: Give to homeroom teacher

PINK SLIP:

1. Put in John's box
2. John will chart and put pink copy in Denise's box
3. Denise will collect forms and write served and date served on form

Denise will staple white detention form and completed ASK form together and file.

Reminder:

- After two lunch detentions, third offense will be an after-school detention
- Phone calls made home regarding behavior and lunches with teacher will be dated and charted on log
- Continual emails regarding a student's behavior will be printed and a copy will be placed in Denise's box for filing
- **A student's repeated disturbance with other teachers will be discussed and Homeroom teacher will write detention slip.**

Procedure for Serving Detention

- Student is responsible for reporting to detention area on designated day, failure to do so will result in another detention.
- Student eats in silence, completes detention form and reports to lunchroom to clean tables at 12:50. Carole needs to be informed if a student will be cleaning tables, otherwise table washers will precede.
